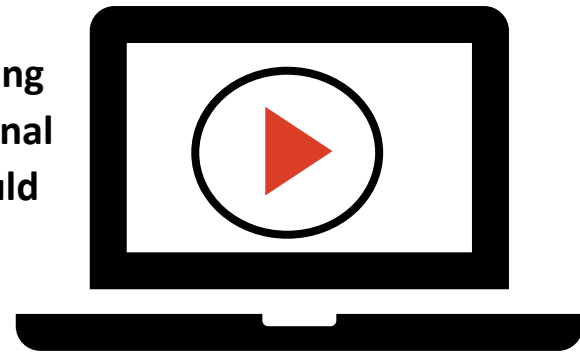




Call for English Learner Methods Videos
